Course Overview

Next Steps - Sequencing Movements and Applying Auxiliaries in Clear Aligner Therapy is an intensive, 14-hour professional development course held over two days, targeting dental professionals with foundational clear aligner training and clinical experience.

The course focuses on advanced sequencing of tooth movements and the integration of auxiliary devices within clear aligner therapy to address more challenging cases. The curriculum builds upon basic clear aligner principles, emphasizing advanced treatment planning and execution.

The **first day** covers sequencing tooth movements, highlighting biomechanical considerations for efficient and predictable orthodontic outcomes, considering various malocclusion scenarios. The **second day** concentrates on auxiliary devices like thermopliers and elastics, teaching participants to incorporate these into comprehensive treatment plans for enhanced predictability. The course will conclude with the review and discussion of cases brought in by the participants.

Participants will conclude the course with a deeper understanding of clear aligner therapy's advanced aspects, equipped to manage a broader spectrum of orthodontic cases with improved clinical outcomes.

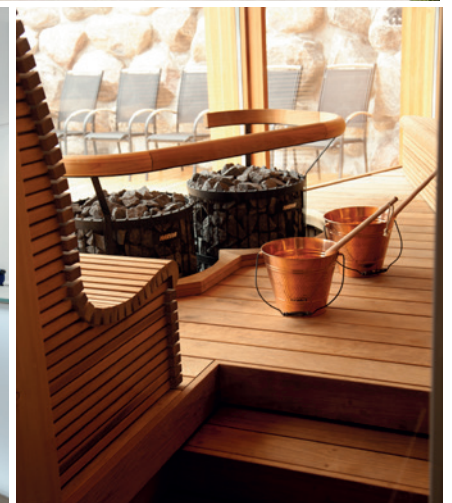

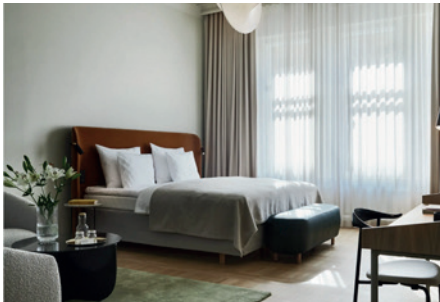

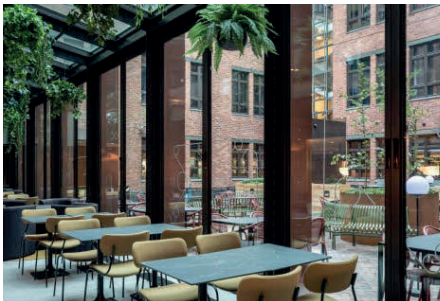
