Depletion of oral tissue due to trauma, aging, and bacteria requires innovative approaches in periodontal surgery and implantology. This presentation discusses modern therapies aiming for tissue regeneration, focusing on both biological recovery and aesthetic results. Procedures often use xenogeneic materials for soft tissue and bone regeneration, offering advantages in availability and eliminating the need for traumatic graft harvesting. The lecture provides an overview of these strategies, emphasizing the effective use of xenografts and their adaptability to enhance patient outcomes. Overall, it promotes the integration of xenografts to advance care standards in private practice.

Immediate implantation in private practice: rationale and implementation

Tooth extraction is a routine dental procedure, often necessitating replacement with fixed or removable restorations. Dentists must carefully evaluate available options with patients.

Alongside simple extraction, strategies such as Alveolar Ridge Preservation and Immediate Implant Placement offer alternatives at the time of tooth extraction. Success in immediate implantation hinges on several key factors. This presentation provides a comprehensive overview of post-extraction biological processes, delves into the rationale and methodology behind immediate implant placement, and equips clinicians with essential insights for informed decision-making during extractions.

Dentistry has always greatly fascinated Dr. Marco Zeltner – and still does today. After five years as assistant dentist here in Horgen, Dr. Zeltner went to the University of Zurich, where he studied to become a specialist for reconstructive dental medicine. His focus in dentistry lies in aesthetic dentistry and the replacement of missing teeth with reconstructions of teeth and implants. In addition to working with patients, Dr. Zeltner places great emphasis on contributing to dentistry in general as well. Currently, he is President of the Academic Alumni Association of the Clinic for Dental Crown and Bridge Prosthetics, Partial Prosthetics and Dental Material Science called "KBTMreloaded", and also organizes an advanced training course weekend for dentists.

Dr. Alexis Ioannidis completed his undergraduate studies at the University of Zurich in 2009, and subsequently earned the title of Dr. med. dent. in 2013, followed by the Venia Legendi (Habilitation) for Reconstructive Dentistry in 2021, both from the same university. Since 2017, Dr. Ioannidis has been a full-time Senior Teaching and Research Assistant and, since 2023, Head of Fixed Prosthodontics at the Clinic of Reconstructive Dentistry at the University of Zurich. With an interest in advancing the field of prosthodontics, Ioannidis' primary scientific focus lies in the realm of minimally invasive prosthetic treatment concepts. He has contributed significantly to the field through his publication of over 40 scientific and clinical articles in high-ranked peer-reviewed journals.
